Assessment

You'll have a phone, video or in-person chat with a friendly A2B needs assessor. This will last about one and a half to two hours.

Together, we'll agree what support we think you need.



Approval

You'll get an email from the funding body within four weeks.

The email will confirm what support you'll get, and let you know about your approved suppliers.
